## Your Right To Have A Doula

### New Mexico Doula Access Policy

*In accordance with the New Mexico Doula Credentialing and Access Act:*

**You have the right to select a doula of your choice to accompany you within this facility during:**

**PREGNANCY  
CARE**

**CHILDBIRTH**  
(Labor & Delivery)

**12-MONTH  
POSTPARTUM  
PERIOD**

A doula is a trained, non-medical support person who provides physical, emotional, and informational support during pregnancy, childbirth, and the postpartum period.

**This facility authorizes and welcomes doulas as part of your support team under our written policies and procedures.**



You may choose a doula regardless of birth outcome (e.g., planned delivery, induction, cesarean, etc.)



Your doula may be present with you on facility premises consistent with our policies.
