Shorten the distance between healing and home. The Swing Bed Program at Roosevelt General Hospital provides individualized, specialty-focused care for patients who require additional time to heal and recover before returning home.

This program serves patients who need rehabilitation after surgical procedures, periods of debility, or other medical conditions. Patients receive skilled, comprehensive care designed to support a safe transition back to the home environment.



Why do patients need Swing Bed care? Our goal is to help patients return home safely. Swing bed services can help patients

· Long-term IV antibiotic therapy

Wound care

who need:

- · Post-operative care after a surgical procedure
- Therapy after a stroke, accident or injury
- Rehab or skilled care after a recent hospitalization

What types of care are offered through Swing Bed? The Swing Bed program provides skilled care including:

- Nursing
- Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation
- Occupational Therapy
- Respiratory Therapy
- Speech Therapy
- Nutrition Services

Will insurance cover the cost for Swing Bed services?

Medicare, Managed Medicare and some private insurance programs cover the costs for qualified skilled care. It's recommended you contact your insurance provider and inquire about Swing Bed services.

Leaving the hospital can be difficult, especially if you and your healthcare team decide your recovery or continued-care needs cannot be met at home.
